What type of waste is produced in Brunei?

The composition of waste in Brunei consists of almost 36% of food waste. A significant portion of waste,55% (Paper,plastic,metal,glass,wood,and textiles),is recyclable waste 20. Oily waste accounts for a large part of the waste generated from industrial sectors.

Does Brunei have a solid waste problem?

Provided by the Springer Nature SharedIt content-sharing initiative Brunei,similar to other nations,encounters difficulties in effectively managing solid waste,with 70% of the waste ending up in landfills,2% through composting,and the remainder being disposed of through conventional methods.

Who collects waste in Brunei Darussalam?

There are two government bodies: the Department of Environment,Park and Recreational (JASTRe),responsible for collecting waste in Brunei Darussalam,and the Municipal Department,responsible for collecting municipal waste in the municipal area 18.
