Can I send batteries through air freight?

When sending everyday lithium metal (non-rechargeable) batteries by air freight, you must send them inside the product they work in. For example, if you send your TV remote and choose to send your current half-used AAA batteries as well, the batteries must be sent inside the TV remote.

Can I send Spare lithium batteries by air freight?

You cannot send loose spare lithium metal batteries by air freight. Sending lithium-ion batteries by air freight is similar to the rules you must follow when sending lithium batteries by sea freight. You can choose to send them inside their respective devices, or you can send them separately in a container with a hard case.

Can you move lithium ion batteries by air freight?

When considering your equipment seek options where your batteries fall within these categories. Finally, there are both Lithium Ion and Lithium Metal batteries on the market. In general, it is easier to move Lithium Ion batteries by air freight as they are more exempted from regulations.

Why are lithium batteries difficult to ship by air freight?

Lithium batteries power everything from phones to cars to medical devices, yet they are among the most difficult items to ship by air freight! Many countries and virtually all airlines have strict regulations regarding the shipment of lithium batteries because they have the potential to cause catastrophic damage to aircraft if anything goes wrong.

Used cell phones will be transported only when packaged and labeled in compliance with 49 C.F.R. 172 (Hazardous Materials) for ground ...

The outer packaging does not need to be UN Specification packaging - in fact, the equipment can be transported unpackaged if it provides adequate protection to the battery.
