Where will Warsaw build its first nuclear power station?

Warsaw wants to build its first commercial nuclear power station near the villages of Lubiatowo and Kopalino on its northern Baltic Sea coast in the province of Pomerania. In 2022, the country chose US-based Westinghouse to supply its AP1000 pressurised water reactor technology for the project.

Where will Poland's first nuclear power plant be located?

On December 22, 2021, PEJ announced the preferred location for Poland's first commercial nuclear power plant as the Baltic Sea coastal commune of Choczewo in Wejherowo County, Pomeranian Voivodeship at a site called Lubiatowo-Kopalino.

Will Westinghouse build a second nuclear power station in Poland?

In late 2023, Westinghouse and US-partner Bechtel jointly formed a consortium that will implement the project. Bechtel is carrying out geological studies at the Lubiatowo-Kopalino site since May. Poland has not chosen a second nuclear power station site, although several options in central Poland had been mentioned.
